

THE COOKIES POLICY

1. This Service does not automatically gather any information other than that contained in cookies.
2. Cookies are electronic data files, and, in particular, text files, stored on Service User devices and used by Service websites. Most cookies contain the name of their website of origin, the storage life on device and a unique number.
3. Cookies are stored and accessed on Service User devices by the Service operator, i.e. Kompania Piwowarska S.A. headquartered at ul. Emilii Plater 53, 00-113 Warsaw.
4. We use cookies to:
 - a) tailor Service website content to User preferences and optimize website use; in particular, cookies allow us to identify Service User devices and properly display websites accordingly to User's individual needs and preferences;
 - b) gather analytics to understand Service User behavior within our websites and improve website design and content;
 - c) sustain sessions of logged-in Service Users to keep them from having to re-enter logins and passwords when navigating between Service pages;
5. The Service relies on two basic types of cookies: session and persistent. Session cookies are temporary files stored on User devices until Users log out, leave a website or close their application (web browser). Persistent cookies are stored on User devices for a definite duration as given in cookie specifications or until deleted by User.
6. The Service uses the following cookie types:
 - a) necessary cookies which support the use of any services available in the Service – these include authorization cookies used to access any Service areas which require authorization;
 - b) security cookies used to e.g. detect breaches of Service access authorization;
 - c) capacity cookies, which allow us to gather information on the way in which the Service pages are used;
 - d) functionality cookies, which allow us to remember User settings and personalize User interface by activating the language and regional settings corresponding to the User's region, and set font size, website layout, etc.;
 - e) advertising cookies, which allow us to provide the User with advertising content which

better reflect their interests.

7. Many website browsing applications (search engines) store cookies on User devices by default. Service Users may change their cookie settings at any time, in particular by blocking automatic cookie management in website preferences or demanding notification before any cookies are stored on their device. To learn more about cookie management options, see software (browser) settings.
8. The Service operator notes that restrictions on the use of cookies may affect certain functionalities available on Service web pages.
9. The cookies stored on Service User devices may also be used by advertisers and partners cooperating with the Service operator.
